

# Three Use Cases

Every Conversation Case has its own Case Tutorial Video. Each video tutorial (~ 5-13 min) walks through the entire case, from articles and videos to the discussion questions. The voice-over is basically the same as if you were to read the case verbatim. We know that you, as a facilitator, may want to personalize the approach — and we certainly encourage you do so — but this video is a great starting point either as a model for you to use as you're preparing or as a de facto facilitator for the actual event. Take a look at three possible use cases for these Case Tutorial Videos.



## Consider

1. Before hosting a Conversation Case, watch the Case Tutorial Video to hear how the case can be presented. We've modeled everything from pacing to sequencing to tone.
2. If you don't feel comfortable facilitating a Conversation Case with a small group, you can use this video as a de facto facilitator. Simply play this video and pause at the appropriate points to ignite a discussion or play the designated video clip.
3. Not all parents will be able to attend your event. Consider sharing one of the Video Tutorials, and have parents walk themselves through the Conversation Case by watching the video with materials in hand. Of course, these parents won't have the benefit of hearing other parents' perspectives during the discussion, but this Case Tutorial Video is a great way to keep them informed about the topics and information that their school covered.
